Christmas FM raises €70,000 for Simon Communities for Cork and Dublin

Charity radio station Christmas FM, which broadcast during December 2009, raised over €70,000 for the Simon Communities of Dublin and Cork, including €5,256.07 through a dedicated EBS Christmas FM Account. The total raised was more than double the station's original target of €35,000. Donations were raised through corporate sponsorship, texts and online donations.
